The provisions of the Court's <u>Electronic Case Filing (ECF) Administrative Procedures Manual</u>, as it may be modified from time to time, are incorporated by reference into this agreement to the extent that such provisions apply to filing, assigning, transferring, or withdrawing Proofs of Claim or filing Reaffirmation Agreements.
- 4. A registered user is responsible and liable for any documents submitted electronically to the System by means of the user's login and password.
- 5. A registered user's System eligibility may be restricted or revoked for any of the following reasons:
 - knowingly permitting his/her System password to be utilized by anyone who is not authorized to utilize the password
 - filing documents on behalf of someone who is not a registered user
 - failing to comply with any of his/her other obligations set forth in this agreement.
